

What Inspires Art?

A Talk by Dr Kevin Byron

This talk asks some basic questions about creativity and the creative process and then describes some common perennial patterns of creative ideas appearing in a variety of forms including art and science. Then Dr Byron will go on to discuss his book 'What Inspires Art?' published last year that came about as a result of the Usher Open art competition. This book is a collection of images and stories of inspiration by 110 Lincolnshire artists and is currently on sale at the Usher gallery.

Dr Kevin Byron has a background of research in physics for some 25 years and later developed a passion for education and taught at the University of Leicester and then at Queen Mary, University of London.

More recently he undertook research in creative thinking skills in art and science. This ultimately led to him compiling and editing the book.
